<p>Student Reference Point</p> <p>Es gibt – there is/ there are</p> <p>Use es gibt einen/eine/ein to say that there is something: Es gibt einen Keller – there is a cellar</p> <p>Use es gibt keinen/ keine/kein to say that there isn't something: Es gibt keinen Keller – there isn't a cellar</p>	<p>Some ways to make your sentences more interesting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use connectives – und and aber - Use qualifiers – sehr, ziemlich, nicht sehr - Give opinions – ich finde es toll/ gut/ok/furchtbar <p>Prepositions in the dative</p> <p>Words like <i>auf, in</i> and <i>unter</i> are called prepositions, After the preposition, <i>der, die</i> and <i>das</i> change:</p> <p>Der Schreibtisch = <i>auf dem</i> Schreibtisch Die Kommode = <i>in der</i> Kommode Das Bett = <i>unter dem</i> Bett</p>
<p>Word Order</p> <p>In statements the verb is always the <u>second</u> idea:</p> <p>Ich habe einen Schreibtisch.</p> <p>In meinem Zimmer habe ich einen Schreibtisch.</p>	<p>How do I learn new words?</p> <p>Little and often: Choose a few words to learn after every German lesson.</p> <p>Be selective: Learn the most useful words first – words you can use in different situations. These are called “ high frequency words.”</p> <p>Experiment: Try different revision methods to see what works for you. For example sticking notes on objects, getting a friend to test you, make flash cards.</p>

Giving Directions

„du“ und „Sie“

German has more than one word for 'you'.

Use **du** when you are talking to a young person, or a friend or relative.

Use **Sie** when you are talking to an adult you do not know well.

Wo ist	der Markt / der Park? die Kirche / die Post? das Rathaus / das Verkehrsamt?	
Geh	geradeaus.	
Nimm die	erste / zweite / dritte Straße	links. rechts.
Der / Die / Das ...	ist auf der linken / rechten Seite.

When you see a German noun that looks familiar but has a “strange” ending on it, it is probably the plural form.
