



Subject: Music A-level (Enrichment Material)

<p>Research the life and works of one of the most famous classical composers.</p>	<p>Read a concert review (you could look on Classic FM or the BBC pages to help find one.)</p>
<p>Write a diary entry from the perspective of a composer you have studied or researched, whilst they were composing a particular piece. Try to imagine their thought processes and inspiration.</p>	<p>Compose a piece of music that reflects the theme 'isolation'. This can be done using music software or can be played live and recorded.</p>
<p>Perform a piece you have learnt to an audience (this could be the people in your home or virtually via a video call service.)</p>	<p>Watch an opera. Check out the Royal Opera houses of every country to find a variety of titles available to stream, this may be a once in a lifetime opportunity to access so much high-quality opera for free!</p>
<p>Analyse a short piece of music from the Baroque, Classical or Romantic era noting the key features of harmony, melody, structure and instrumentation.</p>	<p>Listen to the Saturday morning classic coffee concert (an online version of the concerts usually held at St Michael's Church, Sittingbourne.) Search Classic Coffee Concerts on YouTube, or livestream via their Facebook page on Saturday mornings at 10.45am.</p>
