GEOGRAPHY Year 7

Your task is to produce an information booklet on an actual river in the world.

First you need to decide which river you are going to find out about. Below is a list of rivers you may wish to choose from but feel free to pick one which does not appear on this list, just make sure you can find the relevant information you need.

Possible rivers: Thames, Nile, Amazon, Colorado, Rhine.

What you could include:

- Where the source of the river is.
- The name of Sea or Ocean that the river flows into at the end.
- Any other information like how wide it is.
- A map showing its path.
- Names of major places along it and any other features like dams or landmarks.

How to lay it out:

The information booklet can be done on computer or by hand, it is totally up to you. The only thing you must do is put your name on it and the name of the river.

Try to make it look professional and attractive. Include pictures, use subheadings but please **do not** copy and paste huge pieces of text straight from the internet.

Journey along the river:

Imagine you are a bird that is flying from the source of the river to the end of the river at the sea; write a creative piece/ poem/ etc to describe the journey from source to mouth.

You could also draw a series of illustrations to go with each section of the river.

How are rivers used?

Use the internet of your local library to find out how these different rivers are used by people in different places in the world.
