 Create a portrait in the style of Frida Kahlo. Incorporate animals that symbolise and express your personality.	 Go on a virtual tour of the National Portrait gallery. Check out their contemporary exhibition space. Write down your highlights.	 Watch an episode of Portrait Artist of the Year.
 Research Frida Kahlo and find out why she is a renowned inspirational female artist. Present your findings creatively.	 Enter Turner Contemporary's Portfolio Art Competition, creating a piece in response to the theme Places and Spaces.	 Write an article about how social media has impacted on the arts.
 Create a starter task for an art lesson.	 Draw a continuous line drawing from observation of your surroundings.	 Discuss and debate: What would the world be like if there was no Art and Design?
 Create a 5-minute portrait drawing each day for two weeks. Present this as a concertina.	 Drawing with scissors...challenge! Create your own Pablo Picado papercut outcome.	 Create an A4 response inspired by Mexican Folk Art. This can be any medium, but should be bursting with patterns and colour!
 Select a new artist whose work you like, find out some information about them and present your findings and opinion to your class.
