Take a virtual trip to the West End or a local concert venue. Many theatres and performers are now streaming amazing live performances online, for free! You do not need to leave your home in order to hear world-class performances, so make the most of this once in a lifetime opportunity!	 Create a 3D piano keyboard, using recycled items. It does not have to be full size but should be roughly to scale! If you are able to take a photograph and stick into your music book that would be great!
