












SUPER-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

DRAMA Year 8

 Watch a film version of A Midsummer Night's Dream.	 Design the set. Include labels and measurements. Research set design sketches to aid you – remember to identify the locations!	 Write a monologue (speech) by Puck to the audience – introducing the whole play at the beginning.
 Helena is annoyed about Hermia gaining all the male attention. How would you (as Helena) perform the line "I'm as ugly as a bear!" to an audience? <i>Refer to two vocal skills and two detailed physical skills.</i>	 Read the full version of A Midsummer Night's Dream by William Shakespeare.	 Draw a body (of any character in A Midsummer Night's Dream) on A4 paper – inside put adjectives to describe your selected character.
 Design/sketch and label the costumes for Helena/Hermia. Refer to colour, length, fit, condition, style, material and accessories. How will they contrast to reveal the characters?	 Ask a member of your family to 'hot seat' you (ask you questions), whilst you take on any role of your choice from A Midsummer Night's Dream.	 Read more of Shakespeare's plays or even listen to an audio recording.
