Many theatres and performers are now streaming amazing live performances online, for free! You do not need to leave your home in order to hear world-class performances, so make the most of this once in a lifetime opportunity! |  Create a 3D musical instrument suitable for use in popular or film music, using recycled items. It does not have to be full size but should be roughly to scale! If you are able to take a photograph and stick it into your book that would be great! |
