

















SUPER-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Pre-GCSE: Modern Foreign Languages Year 9

 Research a French/German celebrity and write 100 words about them in your own words.	 Research the traditional clothes and foods of a French/German speaking country or region. Present the information in your own words, including pictures to illustrate your work.	 Take a virtual trip to the 'Institut français' or the 'Goethe Institute'. Follow Link 1 or Link 2 (below)
 Write a brochure about your town for tourists in French or German. Include reviews from travellers using the past tense.	 Write about a mysterious event in French or German and relate what has happened using the past tense. (120 words)	 Design a new and healthy school menu in French or German, including at least four main courses, a vegetarian option, side plates, desserts and drinks.
 Watch a French/German advert on a product of your choice. Write a list of the adjectives used and their English translations. Why did you choose this advert? (provide a link) Would it encourage you to buy the product or use the service? Give reasons for your decision.	 Watch a cartoon in French/German, adding the subtitles if needed. Write list or make a grid of 15 words which you understand. (Write the words in English as well as in the target Language.)	 Read a French/German weather forecast. Print it out. Write a brief summary of the weather types which you understand in English.
 Listen to a French/German song and learn the lyrics. Print off the lyrics. Write about your opinion of the song. Why did you choose that song?	 Listen to a French/German radio channel and list all the words you can hear.	 Record a presentation on your town/local area. (60 – 90 seconds.) This could take the form of a guided tour.
 Prepare and lead an introduction lesson on a section of vocabulary of your choice. Think about giving tips on how to memorise. Make a PowerPoint presentation and an accompanying help sheet for your peers.	 Prepare and lead an introduction lesson to the perfect tense. Make a PowerPoint presentation to accompany your lesson.	 Record a presentation on your hobbies and why you like them. (60 – 90 seconds.)
